

## Foreign Policy

### General

- The United States needs to be a representative for peace and economic development.
- More positive peace efforts need to be undertaken. The U.S. should also focus on initiatives that improve the human condition – schools, wells, hospitals, electricity, etc.
- The US Peace Corps should be expanded, as an instrument of peace and development.

### Middle East Policy (Iraq, Iran, Israel, Palestine)

- End the Occupation - Immediately. The ongoing occupation of Iraq, like the initial invasion, is illegal, immoral, unjustified and motivated by the agenda of a narrow tier of corporate interests. It is adding to, rather than calming, the chaos and ethnic tensions in that country. It is adding to the death toll, not reducing it, making Iraq less secure today and our own future less secure tomorrow.
- We will fight for a complete and immediate withdrawal from Iraq, while seeking assistance from the United Nations to help the Iraqi people restore order and genuine self-determination, with reparations from the United States to fund genuine reconstruction.
